



## Your Lucky Number is

Start calculating your lucky number by writing the day you were born on the green line at the top. To give you an example, I put number 7 in purple to represent someone born Aug. 7.

Write your current age at the bottom left hand corner. The person in our example is 48.

Put any number up to 100 next to "Death" at the bottom right corner. Our example uses 99. Add your birth and life numbers. Put the total inside the circle on the left side of the triangle. The example shows 55.

Add your birth and death numbers. Put the total inside the circle on the right side of the triangle. The example shows 106.

Add the life and death numbers. Put the total inside the circle on the bottom of the triangle. The example shows 147.

Add the numbers at the opposite ends of each line running through the center of triangle. In our example, they equal 154. Put your totals on the blue lines. That's your lucky number! To get your single-digit lucky number, add the separate numerals. For 154: 1 + 5 + 4 = 10. Since 1 + 0 = 1, the number reduces to 1.
